CODE OF ETHICS OF THE FILIPINO COMPUTING AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PROFESSIONAL

Preamble: I will use my knowledge and skills for the benefit of society. I will serve employers and clients with integrity, subject to an overriding responsibility to serve the public interest, and I will strive to enhance the competence and prestige of the profession. By these, I mean:

- I will prioritize the general welfare and public good in the performance of my work;
- I will only make factual claims about my areas of competence;
- I will truthfully declare the capabilities and qualities of my products and services;
- I will always strive to provide the highest quality in the products and services I offer, utilizing my skills with competence and professionalism;
- I will accept full responsibility for the work I have done;
- I will not disclose or use any confidential information obtained in the course of professional duties without the prior consent of the parties concerned, except when otherwise required by law;
- I will comply with and strictly adhere to intellectual property laws, patent laws, and other laws relevant to computing and information technology;
- I will not knowingly participate in the development of computing and information technology systems that promote the commission of fraud and other unlawful acts;
- I will promote public knowledge, understanding, and appreciation for computing and information technology;
- I will uphold and improve computing and information technology professional standards through:
 - Active membership in at least one (1) general computing and information technology professional association
 - Conscious awareness of and planning for compliance with education, training, experience, assessment, and certification requirements of my chosen career
 - Intentional engagement in aligned continuing professional development
 - Voluntary participation in activities that help individuals preparing for or already engaged in computing and information technology occupations to meet industry requirements and standards
 - Utilizing my time, talent, and leadership to foster recognition of, respect for, and pride in the prestige of the computing and information technology profession

I therefore consciously and voluntarily commit, throughout my professional life, to collaborate with other professionals and support and work with programs, projects, initiatives, and advocacies that seek to support, protect, and advance the global competitiveness of the Philippines and its computing and information technology profession and sector.

OBJECTIVES OF PHILIPPINE COMPUTER SOCIETY

- To actively participate in and support initiatives that enhance the competitiveness of the Philippines and Filipinos in a global economy;
- To promote regional and international exchanges and cooperation in the field of IT and related technologies, fostering collaboration and knowledge sharing;

- To promote continuing education, research, and intellectual inquiry regarding information systems, staying ahead of the curve and driving progress;
- To encourage and promote professionalism among its members, upholding the highest standards of ethics and conduct;
- To provide a range of services to its members and partners, including access to resources, training, and networking opportunities.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

1. *Who can apply to become a partner institution/organization?*

Any institution or organization authorized by the relevant government agency, sharing common objectives and capable of providing complementary resources, expertise, or capabilities in the holistic advancement of ICT professionals or information technology.

2. *Who can be endorsed to serve as the designated official representative of a partner to the Philippine Computer Society?*

An individual who meets the requirements for individual membership in PCS can be endorsed by the institution/organization to officially represent the institution as an education partner of PCS.

3. *Who can apply for individual membership in PCS?*

An individual employed in a computing or information technology-related field is eligible to apply for individual membership in PCS. This individual may serve as a faculty member, teacher, or trainer involved in research management, supervision, or instructional activities within the realm of computing or information technology. They may or may not simultaneously hold a position primarily focused on computing or IT-related tasks within an IT supplier, telecommunications vendor, or other enterprise centered on IT/ICT as its core business. Additionally, they may or may not simultaneously work primarily in computing or IT-related roles within an enterprise whose core business is unrelated to IT/ICT.

The scope of such an individual's occupation may include:

- a. Development, distribution, implementation, support, and operation of telecommunication, computer hardware/software, and multimedia content.
- b. Provision of information services to end-users.
- c. Management of any of the aforementioned processes.

4. *What are the benefits of being a Partner?*

- Receipt of a certificate acknowledging the institution's affiliation as a PCS partner
- Representation of the partner at essential meetings and events
- Equivalent rights and privileges of the official representative to individual PCS members
- Exclusive discounts for significant PCS events, seminars, and conferences
